| Industry

All industries are verified using employer-submitted NAICS codes and our internal classification engine.

| Size

Use employee count to compare with organizations of similar scale. Bnchmrk supports six standard size brackets:

- Under 100

- 100 to 250
- 250 to 500
- 500 to 1000
- 1000 to 5000
- 5000 and Up

Size is one of the strongest predictors of benefit plan design and structure. For the most accurate results, apply a size filter unless you're benchmarking against a mixed-size population.

| Location (State)

Bnchmrk supports state-level filtering across all 50 U.S. states and the District of Columbia. This allows for regional benchmarking, especially useful for:

- Regionally priced plans
- State-specific benefit mandates
- Multi-office benchmarking

You can also select multiple states to create a composite cohort.
